# GAME NOTES

**TONIGHT'S GAME** – The Colorado Eagles take on the Manitoba Moose tonight for the third time this season and for the first time ever at the Budweiser Events Center.

**THE SEASON SERIES** – The Moose lead the season series with a record of 2-0-0 against Colorado after collecting a pair of wins over the Eagles at Bell MTS Place in Winnipeg on December 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup>.

**THE ALL-TIME SERIES** – This is the third meeting between Colorado and Manitoba, as the two clubs are set to meet four times during the 2018-19 regular season.

**EAGLES' LAST GAME (3/17)** – The Colorado Eagles nine-game winning streak came to an end in a 9-0 loss to the San Jose Barracuda on Sunday. Josef Korenar earned the 31-save shutout in net, as eight different skaters found the back of the net for San Jose.

**MOOSE'S LAST GAME (3/19)** – Moose forward Kristian Vesalainen scored the game-winning goal with 13 seconds remaining in overtime to propel Manitoba to a 4-3 victory over San Diego on Tuesday. The Moose scored the first three goals in the contest, but the Gulls would roar back with the final three goals of regulation to force the extra session.

**LAST MEETING (12/31)** – Moose goaltender Eric Comrie made 31 saves on 32 shots, while Manitoba netted four goals from four different goal scorers to defeat the Colorado Eagles, 4-1. Eagles forward Scott Kosmachuk scored Colorado's lone goal in the contest. Goalie Pavel Francouz suffered the loss in net, allowing three goals on 26 shots.

**UP NEXT FOR THE EAGLES** – Colorado will face the Manitoba Moose for the final time this season on Saturday, March 23<sup>rd</sup> at 7:05pm MT at the Budweiser Events Center.

**THE SCENARIO-** The Eagles currently have 70 points with eight games left in the regular season. Colorado is tied with San Jose for third place in the Pacific Division and trail San Diego by just one point for second place. After tonight, Colorado will have seven games remaining, with four of those contests on the road and three set for the Budweiser Events Center.

**PLAYOFF PUSH-** Colorado's magic number to clinch a spot in the 2019 AHL Calder Cup Playoffs is 14. Any combination of Eagles wins or Tucson losses that reaches 14 points in the standings will punch Colorado's ticket to the post season. The Eagles and Roadrunners will clash in a pair of games next weekend in Tucson. The two-game set will put eight potential points on the line in Colorado's pursuit of that magic number of 14.
