GAME NOTES

TONIGHT'S GAME – The Colorado Eagles take on the San Jose Barracuda tonight for the seventh time this season and for the third time at the Budweiser Events Center.

THE SEASON SERIES – The Eagles are 3-3-0 against San Jose and have gone 2-0-0 against the Barracuda this season at the Budweiser Events Center.

THE ALL-TIME SERIES – This is the third meeting between Colorado and San Jose, as the two teams will close out the 2018-19 regular season with a rematch tomorrow night.

EAGLES' LAST GAME (4/7) – Colorado Eagles goaltender Spencer Martin made 28 saves on 30 shots and shut down three of Chicago's four shooters in a shootout to backstop the Eagles to a 3-2 victory over the Wolves on Sunday. Eagles forward Logan O'Connor notched a goal and an assist in the win, while fellow forward Andrew Agozzino posted a pair of assists.

BARRACUDA'S LAST GAME (4/10) – San Diego scored a pair of goals late in the third period, but it would not be enough as San Jose would hang on for a 4-3 victory over the Gulls on Wednesday. Forward Maxim Letunov collected a goal and two assists in the win.

LAST MEETING (3/17) – The Colorado Eagles nine-game winning streak came to an end in a 9-0 loss to the San Jose Barracuda at SAP Center in San Jose. Josef Korenar earned the 31-save shutout in net, as eight different skaters found the back of the net for the Barracuda.

If the Eagles win tonight and Tucson loses tonight in regulation, Colorado will clinch a playoff spot and face Bakersfield in the first round.

YOUTH MOVEMENT- Eagles forward Logan O'Connor comes into the final weekend of the regular season having scored a goal in each of his last two games and has posted three goals and four assists in the last five contests. The 22 year-old has now netted 18 goals in his first professional season, after scoring 16 goals in his three years at the University of Denver.
