**TONIGHT'S GAME** – The Colorado Eagles take on the Stockton Heat tonight for the first time in team history.

**THE SEASON SERIES** –The Eagles will face Stockton a total of eight times during the regular season, with four of those eight games set to take place at the Budweiser Events Center.

**THE ALL-TIME SERIES** – Tonight marks the first meeting between the Eagles and Heat, both teams are members of the AHL's Pacific Division of the Western Conference.

**EAGLES' LAST GAME (11/10)** – Andrew Agozzino netted a power-play goal and a shorthanded tally, but it would not be enough, as the Eagles fell to the San Diego Gulls, 3-2 on Saturday. Pavel Francouz made 40 saves on 43 shots in the loss, as Gulls forward Troy Terry collected the game-winning goal late in the third period to seal the victory.

**HEAT'S LAST GAME (11/11)** – The Ontario Reign built a 4-0 lead after two periods of play to carry them to a 4-1 victory over the Stockton Heat on Sunday. Heat goaltender Jon Gillies suffered the loss, surrendering four goals on 23 shots before giving way to fellow netminder Nick Schneider early in the third period.

**SETTING THE PACE-** Forward Andrew Agozzino has been a regular fixture on the scoresheet for Colorado this season. The 27 year-old leads the Eagles with 14 points in 12 games and also leads the team with seven goals on the year. Agozzino enters tonight's game riding a six-game point streak, netting six goals and four assists during that stretch. He has posted at least one point in 10 of his last 11 contests, overall.

**PK PROWESS-** The Eagles penalty kill has been one of the best in the league in the early portion of the season. Through the first 12 games of the year, Colorado ranks 7<sup>th</sup> in the AHL with a penalty kill percentage of 86.8%. In addition, the Eagles have netted a shorthanded goal each of the team's last two contests.
