KEY TAKEAWAYS

TONIGHT'S GAME – The Colorado Eagles take on the Tucson Roadrunners tonight in the second game of a two-game series.

THE SERIES – Colorado will face Tucson 12 times this season, with six of those games taking place at the Budweiser Events Center. The Eagles lead the season series with a record of 3-2, including wins in each of the last three meetings.

THE ALL-TIME SERIES – The Eagles are 12-5-0 all-time against the Roadrunners, including a 6-1-0 mark in games played at the BEC.

EAGLES' LAST GAME (1/10) – The Colorado Eagles stormed out to a 4-0 lead in the first period to help secure a 5-1 victory over the Tucson Roadrunners on Friday. Adam Werner earned his 13th win of the season in net, stopping 26 of the 27 shots he faced in the contest. The victory now gives Colorado points in 12-straight games and wins in nine of the Eagles last 10 games.

BY THE NUMBERS

ON A HEATER- A 5-1 win over Tucson last night now gives the Eagles points in the standings in each of their last 12 contests and wins in nine of their last 10 games. Their 12-game point streak is the longest current point streak in the AHL. The Milwaukee Admirals 13-game point streak in the month of November is the longest of the season in the American Hockey League.

ALL-STAR PERFORMER- Eagles forward T.J. Tynan was named to the 2020 AHL Star Team on January 3rd after notching three goals and 21 assists in his first 21 games with the Eagles. The 27-year old has posted points in 11 of his last 14 games and leads Colorado with eight multi-point games. Tynan's 21 assists rank first on the Eagles roster, while his 24 points are tied for 2nd on the team lead.
