TONIGHT'S GAME – The Colorado Eagles take on the San Jose Barracuda tonight in the first game of a two-game series.

THE SERIES – Colorado will face San Jose eight times this season, with four of those games taking place at the Budweiser Events Center. The Eagles trail in the season series with a record of 2-3-0 through the first five meetings.

THE ALL-TIME SERIES – The Eagles are 6-7-0 all-time against the Barracuda, including a 4-2-0 mark in games played at the BEC.

EAGLES' LAST GAME (2/1) – Eagles defenseman Jacob MacDonald scored the game-tying goal late in the third period to force overtime and forward Jayson Megna would net the game-winner in a shootout, as Colorado defeated the Tucson Roadrunners 3-2 on Saturday. Goaltender Hunter Miska stopped 30 of the 32 shots he faced through 65 minutes of action and shutdown all five shooters in the shootout to collect his ninth win of the season in net.

BARRACUDA'S LAST GAME (2/5) – San Diego goaltender Anthony Stolarz made 36 saves on 38 shots as the Gulls defeated the Barracuda 4-2 on Wednesday at SAP Center in San Jose. Forward Ivan Chekovich posted a goal and an assist in the loss, while defenseman and former Eagle Nicolas Meloche collected a pair of assists.

LAST MEETING (1/15) – San Jose scored three goals in the second period and added four more in the third to defeat the Colorado Eagles 7-2. The seven goals were the most allowed by the Eagles this season. Forward Shane Bowers and defenseman Mark Alt scored the Eagles only goals in the loss. Goaltender Adam Werner suffered the defeat in net, surrendering seven goals on 39 shots. Barracuda goalie Josef Korenar earned the win, stopping 23 of the 25 shots he faced.

BY THE NUMBERS

THE RIGHT FOOT- The first period has been the most dominant this season for Colorado, as the Eagles have outscored the opposition 40-24 in the opening 20 minutes of action. That quick start has also led to Colorado scoring the game's first goal in 67% of their contests, going 22-4-2 when netting the first goal of the game. In addition, the Eagles also own a record of 18-4-1 when taking a lead into the first intermission.

POWERING UP- Colorado's power play has been clicking into gear as of late, as the man-advantage has found the back of the net in three straight contests. During that three-game stretch the Eagles have gone 4-16 on the power play, which is good for a 25% success rate. In addition, Colorado has also flexed its muscle on the penalty kill, netting a pair of shorthanded goals in the last four games.
