TONIGHT'S GAME – The Colorado Eagles take on the San Jose Barracuda tonight in the second game of a two-game series.

THE SERIES – Colorado will face San Jose eight times this season, with four of those games taking place at the Budweiser Events Center. The Eagles are tied in the season series with a record of 3-3-0 through the first six meetings.

THE ALL-TIME SERIES – The Eagles are 7-7-0 all-time against the Barracuda, including a 5-2-0 mark in games played at the BEC.

EAGLES' LAST GAME (2/7) – Eagles forward A.J. Greer notched two goals and an assist, while goaltender Hunter Miska turned aside 31 of the 32 shots he faced to help Colorado defeat the San Jose Barracuda 5-1 on Friday. Eagles forwards Erik Condra and Shane Bowers each posted a goal and an assist, while fellow forward Jayson Megna netted his second shorthanded goal in the last three games. The victory was the Eagles third straight win and now pulls them to within two points of second place in the AHL's Pacific Division and just four points out of first place.

BY THE NUMBERS

BARRACUDA BATTLE- Tonight marks the seventh of eight meetings this season between the Eagles and San Jose. Colorado is currently 3-3-0 in the season series, picking up a 5-1 win over the Barracuda last night. Erik Condra and A.J. Greer each have two goals and two assists against San Jose, while Colin Campbell has four assists in five games against the Barracuda. San Jose forwards Jeffery Viel, Lean Bergmann, Noah Gregor and Jayden Halbgewachs have each posted three goals in the season series, while goaltender Josef Korenar is 3-0-0 this year against Colorado with a 1.33 GAA and a .959 save-percentage.

MEGNA-FICENT- Eagles forward Jayson Megna has scored the game-winning goal in two of his last three games, including a shorthanded tally last Friday at Tucson and a shootout winner against the Roadrunners on Saturday. Megna is currently fifth on the team with 26 points, collecting those 16 goals and 10 assists in a span of just 35 games. His 16 goals are tied with Sheldon Dries for the team lead.
