

## KEYTAKEAWAYS

TONIGHT'S GAME - The Colorado Eagles take on the Milwaukee Admirals tonight in the first game of a two-game series.

**THE SERIES –** Colorado will face Milwaukee four times this season, with two of those games taking place at the Budweiser Events Center. The Eagles lead the season series with a record of 2-0-0 through the first two meetings.

**THE ALL-TIME SERIES –** The Eagles are 2-0-0 all-time against the Admirals, this is the first meeting between the two teams to take place at the Budweiser Events Center.

**EAGLES' LAST GAME (2/22)** – Colorado scored five unanswered goals, including three in the third period, to erase a 4-0 deficit and defeat the Bakersfield Condors 5-4 in overtime. Forward A.J. Greer led the way with two goals and two assists, as Julien Nantel, Shane Bowers and Kevin Connauton also had multi-point performances. Colorado finished the night going 2-for-6 on the power play, as goaltender Adam Werner earned the win in net by making 21 saves on 24 shots.

**ADMIRALS' LAST GAME (2/26)** – Milwaukee forward Eeli Tolvanen scored the game-tying goal late in the third period, but San Antonio forward Nolan Steven would bury the game-winner at the 3:36 mark of overtime to hand the Admirals a 5-4 OT loss on Wednesday..

**LAST MEETING (10/19)** – Eagles forward Logan O'Connor scored the game-winning goal 45 seconds into the extra session and added an assist, as the Eagles defeated the Milwaukee Admirals, 3-2. The two teams combined for a season-high 140 penalty minutes in the contest. Colorado goaltender Adam Werner won his third-consecutive start in net, making 34 saves on 36 shots.

WORKING OVERTIME- Each of Colorado's last two games have gone beyond 60 minutes of play, with the Eagles collecting a 2-1 overtime win last Friday at Ontario and a 5-4 OT victory at Bakersfield on Saturday. Colorado is 5-3 this season in games decided in overtime, while compiling a record of 3-1 in contests that have found their winner in a shootout. Interestingly, each of the previous two meetings between the Eagles and Milwaukee have extended past regulation.

**MEGA OUTPUT-** Eagles forward Jayson Megna comes into tonight's game riding a six-game point streak, notching two goals and five assists during that stretch. Megna has tallied a goal in each of his last two contests, including the gamewinner in Colorado's 5-4 overtime victory at Bakersfield last Saturday.
