GAME NOTES

TODAY'S GAME – The Colorado Eagles take on the Texas Stars tonight in the first game of a two-game series.

THE SEASON SERIES – Colorado will face Texas four times this season, with two of those games taking place at the Budweiser Events Center. The Eagles lead the season series with a record of 1-0-0 after defeating the Stars, 5-2 on November 9th.

THE ALL-TIME SERIES – The Eagles are 1-0-0 all-time against the Stars, as tonight marks the first-ever meeting between the two clubs at the Budweiser Events Center.

EAGLES' LAST GAME (3/7) – Eagles goaltender Hunter Miska stopped all 34 shots he faced to earn his second shutout of the season, as Colorado defeated the Ontario Reign, 3-0 on Saturday. Forward T.J. Tynan collected three assists in the win, while fellow forward A.J. Greer earned a 'Gordie Howe Hat Trick' with a goal, an assist and a fight.

STARS' LAST GAME (3/7) – Texas scored three straight goals to break a 1-1 deadlock and defeat the Milwaukee Admirals, 4-1 on Saturday. The Stars went 2-for-3 on the power play, while goaltender Jake Oettinger made 45 saves on 46 shots to earn the win in net. Forwards Jason Robertson and Joel L'Esperance each collected a goal and an assist in the winning effort.

LAST MEETING (11/9) – Colorado Eagles forward A.J. Greer scored a pair of goals, while Logan O'Connor notched a goal and two assists, as Colorado scored a season-high five goals to defeat the Texas Stars, 5-2. Forward Shane Bowers netted his first professional goal and added an assist in the victory. Hunter Miska earned his first win as an Eagles, making 28 saves.

NOTES & NUMBERS

BACKSTOPPING- Colorado goaltender Hunter Miska is fresh off a 34-save shutout of Ontario last Saturday and has won each of his last four starts and 10 of his last 11, overall. Miska currently ranks fourth in the AHL with a save-percentage of .928, while his 2.38 goals-against average ranks ninth among all goalies in the American Hockey League. Over his last three starts, he has made 113 saves on 115, which is good for a .983 save-percentage and a 0.66 GAA.

TRUE ADVANTAGE- This season has seen Colorado go 17-9-1-1 at the Budweiser Events Center, including wins in each of the Eagles last three games on home ice. Colorado has outscored the opposition 10-2 during that three-game stretch. The Eagles enjoy a home record of 15-2-0-0 this season when leading after the first period of play and a mark of 15-0-1-0 at the BEC when holding the lead after two periods.
