KEY TAKEAWAYS

TODAY'S GAME – The Colorado Eagles take on the Texas Stars tonight in the second game of a two-game series.

THE SERIES – Colorado will face Texas four times this season, with two of those games taking place at the Budweiser Events Center. The season series is tied 1-1-0 after the Stars defeated the Eagles 5-4 last night.

THE ALL-TIME SERIES – The Eagles are 1-1-0 all-time against the Stars, as tonight marks just the second-ever meeting between the two clubs at the Budweiser Events Center.

EAGLES' LAST GAME (3/10) – Colorado rallied from a 4-1 deficit in the second period to tie the game at 4-4 but surrendered the game-winning goal early in the third, as the Eagles fell to the Texas Stars 5-4 on Tuesday. Forwards Julien Nantel and Colin Campbell each netted a pair of goals in the loss. Colorado outshot Texas 47-23, including 21 shots in the second period.

BY THE NUMBERS

STAR POWER- Tonight's matchup is just the second-ever game between the Colorado Eagles and Texas Stars at the Budweiser Events Center and is just the third meeting between the two clubs. A.J. Greer, Julien Nantel and Logan O'Connor lead the team with three points in the first two games of the season series. Colorado has three players who spent time playing for Texas in forwards Sheldon Dries, Erik Condra and defenseman Kevin Connauton. Condra posted 20 goals and 34 assists last season for the Stars, while Dries generated 19 goals in the 2017-18 campaign with Texas, adding a team-high 10 goals in the playoffs.

NEXT LEVEL- Colorado forward Julien Nantel concluded the 2018-19 campaign with the Eagles having posted one goal and three assists. Through 34 games this season, Nantel has already posted eight goals and five assists, including a two-goal performance last night. The 23-year old helped Colorado capture back-to-back Kelly Cup Championships in the ECHL in 2017 and 2018.
